

# **Christian Zionists—Forgotten Pioneers of Modern Israel**

#### **Summary**

This episode highlights two deeply moving stories of American Christian communities in the 19th century who believed in God's promises to Israel—and acted on that belief. The Christian Lovers of Zion left Maine to settle in Ottoman-ruled Jaffa, while Horatio and Anna Spafford, following personal tragedy, established the American Colony in Jerusalem. These faithful forerunners helped prepare the land for the Jewish return long before the establishment of modern Israel.

- 1. What motivated these groups to leave everything behind and move to the land of Israel?
- 2. How did hardship refine or challenge their vision?
- 3. What does their story reveal about the role of Gentile believers in God's plan for Israel?
- 4. How can we be modern "pioneers" of prophetic fulfillment?

History remembers nations, but God remembers individuals who step out in faith. These Christian Zionists may be forgotten by textbooks, but heaven surely has not forgotten their obedience.

- Research the American Colony Hotel or Fellowship House Museum online.
- Journal how you might respond to a calling that involves great risk but eternal significance.
- Listen to "It Is Well with My Soul" and reflect on its origin story in light of Scripture.
