- 3. The Hurva Synagogue is a story of destruction and restoration. Where do you see God rebuilding what was broken in your life or community?
- 4. Why do you think God invites us to explore the lesser-known and hidden places both spiritually and physically?
- 5. What part of Jerusalem's story in this episode stirred your heart for prayer?

- Ask the Lord to give you eyes to see His hidden works in Scripture, in Israel, and in your own life.
- Pray for Jerusalem's peace and continued restoration.
- Consider planning a deeper-layer Israel visit beyond the typical tour stops.
